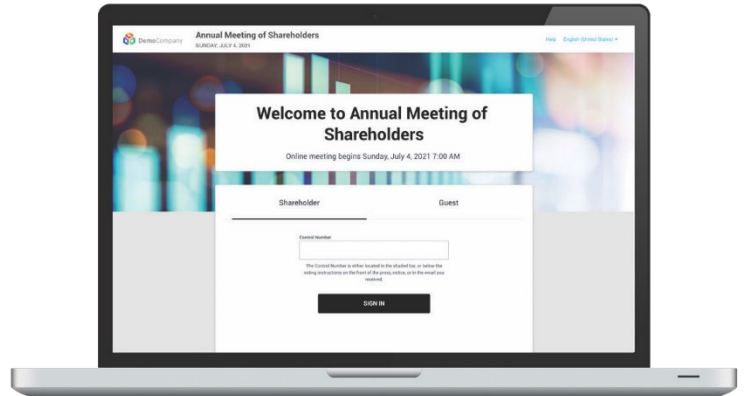


GUIDE TO JOINING THE 2026 GKP AGM

If you choose to participate online you will be able to view a live webcast of the meeting, ask questions and submit your votes in real time.

Meeting Access

19 June 2026 at 1 P.M. (CEST)

You will need the latest version of Chrome, Safari, Edge or Firefox to participate online.

Joining instructions for each shareholder group are provided in Schedule 1 of the Notice of AGM on pages 11 and 12 and below in the "Access" section.

The meeting will start at the above date and time. Access to the meeting will be available from 12.30 P.M. (CEST).

Please ensure your browser is compatible in advance of the meeting.



Access

Click '**JOIN MEETING NOW**'

Once the webpage above has loaded into your web browser, select '**Shareholder**' on the login screen and enter your unique login credentials.

Certificated Shareholders can access the webcast using their meeting ID and username shown on their personalised proxy form. LSE Shareholders with CREST Depository Interests ("CDIs") and holders of Common Shares trading on Euronext Growth Oslo should contact their intermediary. Alternatively, contact Computershare by e-mail at gulfkeystone@computershare.co.uk with evidence of your holding to obtain login credentials.

If you are a guest:

The Company may permit guests to attend at its discretion. Please email gulfkeystone@computershare.co.uk and further details will be provided. Please note any attendance needs to be registered by 17 June 2026.

Technical Issues

If you have trouble logging in, please initially follow the instructions on screen.

If you experience any technical issues with the site you can either call our registrar on the telephone number provided on the site or once you have entered the meeting, you can raise your question using the chat function. If you have technical issues prior to the start of the meeting you should contact our registrar on the shareholder helpline.



Navigation

When successfully authenticated, the home screen will be displayed. You can view company information, ask questions, and watch the webcast.

If viewing on a computer, the webcast will appear automatically once the meeting has started.



Voting

Once the voting has opened, the options will be on your screen.

To vote, simply select your voting direction from the options shown on screen.

Your vote has been cast when the check mark appears. To change your vote, select '**Change My Vote**'.



Questions

Any shareholders who wish to ask a question for consideration at the AGM should send it in advance to investorrelations@gulfkeystone.co.uk by 17 June 2026.

Questions can also be asked at the meeting. Any eligible member attending the meeting remotely is permitted to partake in the discussion. Press the Q&A icon to submit your question.

Type your message into the box at the bottom of the screen and press the '**Send**' button.
